The Uganda Literacy and Education Program

The Canadian International Learning Foundation (CanILF) funds student scholarships and provides educational equipment for a community empowerment program at the Kabira Adult Attention and School for Orphans (KAASO), located in the Rakai District of Uganda. This initiative is part of our Uganda Literacy and Education Program (ULEP).

KAASO provides a program called *Zibula Attitude* ('You Cannot Earn While Sitting') as a community development and empowerment project for adults in the community – mainly women. This program has helped students receive valuable literacy training in the local language (Luganda) and education in basic business, handicrafts, agricultural practices, English and home economics. All of its courses address issues that are important to the community, such as HIV/AIDS, gender equality and environmental stewardship. KAASO's goal is to educate and equip members of the community to empower them to improve their livelihoods.
